TUITION AND FEES

Background

Utah Code, Title 53B grants the Board of Regents with authority to set tuition and miscellaneous fees for each of the USHE institutions. Decisions on tuition and fees usually occur in two phases. In the fall, prior to the annual legislative session, the Board adopts a preliminary first-tier, general percentage increase in tuition for the upcoming academic year that is the same for each institution. Following the legislative session, the Board reviews its preliminary first-tier increases based on legislative funding and makes adjustments. USHE Presidents, in consultation with students, may recommend second-tier tuition increases that target specific unmet budgetary needs at their respective institution. These second-tier tuition increases are subject to approval by the Board of Regents. Proposed miscellaneous fee increases are approved by the Board at that time as well. This tab includes the Board's action on tuition and fees through the 2013-14 academic year.

Explanation of Attachments

Tables 1 and 2 report 2013-14 resident undergraduate tuition and fees for the eight USHE institutions. Table 3 contains the previous ten years of undergraduate tuition and fees for both resident and non-resident students. Table 4 provides historical data on undergraduate tuition by institution for both resident and non-resident students. Table 5 disaggregates the miscellaneous fees charged at eight USHE institutions for 2013-14. Table 6 presents tuition and fees for resident and non-resident graduate students based on program type. Table 7 lists the undergraduate resident and non-resident tuition percentage increases or decreases for the period ranging from 2004-05 to 2013-14. Tables 8 through 11 compare tuition and fees for USHE institutions and similar types of institutions for 2013-14. The comparison institutions are discussed in Tab M.
