

2017 S.B. 117 HIGHER EDUCATION PERFORMANCE FUNDING

- (2) (a) The Department of Workforce Services shall designate, as a targeted job, a job
- 308 that:
- 309 (i) has a base employment level of at least 100 individuals;
- 310 (ii) ranks in the top 20% of jobs for outlook based on:
- 311 (A) projected number of openings; and
- 312 (B) projected rate of growth;
- 313 (iii) ranks in the top 20% of jobs for median annual wage; and
- 314 (iv) requires postsecondary training.
- 315 (b) The Department of Workforce Services shall designate targeted jobs every other
- 316 year.
- 317 (c) GOED may, after consulting with the Department of Workforce Services and
- 318 industry representatives, designate a job that has significant industry importance as a targeted
- 319 job.

5 Star Jobs

STAR RATING PROCESS

- The "star" rating is based on employment outlook and wages.
- Only occupations with employment of at least 100 in the base year are ranked.
- Employment outlook is based 90 percent on the projected number of total Utah job openings between 2014 and 2024 and
 - 10 percent on how fast the occupation is expected to grow over that time period.
- The most recent surveyed median annual wages or contract wages (public education jobs) are used in the wage computation.
- There may be adjustments to the ratings based on an economist's personal knowledge of the labor market.

WHAT THE RANKINGS REPRESENT



Five-star—strongest employment outlook and high wages.



Four-star—good employment outlook and relatively high wages.



• Three-star—moderate to strong employment outlook and low to moderate wages.



Two-star—relatively high wage but a limited employment outlook.



One-Star—relatively low wage and strong employment outlook.

Zero-Stars—limited employment outlook and low wages.

SOC CODES

• Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) system is a <u>federal statistical standard</u> used by federal agencies to classify workers into occupational categories for the purpose of collecting, calculating, or disseminating data.
