WHEREAS, he is a managing general partner at EsNet Group, a privately held investment company; and


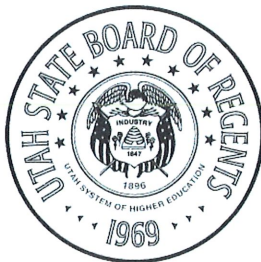
