

## FY 2020-21 Budget Development Process Guidelines

Three budget categories:

1. Compensation and Mandatory Increases

2. Institution Priorities (Performance, CTE)

3. Regent Priority Initiatives

### FY2020-21 Budget Requests

- Compensation and mandatory increases commensurate with state employees (a 2.5% salary and 5% health would be \$36,165,000)
- \$34,850,000 for Performance Funding priorities
- \$3,000,000 for Utah College Access Advisors (UCAC)
