






AAU Publics: In-State Tuition & Fees (2019)



Our Request:

- 2% increase in tuition and 0% increase in fees (~1.7% overall) for AY 2020-21
- Waive start of increase resulting in 0% increase in Fall 2020
- Implement 2% tuition increase in Spring 2021 (~1.7% overall) if conditions are appropriate

Use of Funds From a Full-year 2% Tuition Increase

- •• 25% of 2.5% Compensation Increase/ISF 1.2%/\$4m
- •• Equity promotion/Merit Salary Issues .65%/\$2.2m
- Campus Safety .15%/\$.5m

With Waiver Until January 2021:

~\$2.2m for the above purposes










Energy cost/use Lowest total energy use and cost in past nine years despite 26% growth in building square footage
