

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED TUITION INCREASE

Weber State University is proposing a tuition increase of 2-3%, meaning an additional \$49 to \$73 per semester for a full-time resident undergraduate student for the upcoming school year.



It is proposed this tuition increase be used for the following:

Compensation: up to \$1,125,000  
Retention and Student Support: up to \$901,000  
Mandated Costs: up to \$250,000  
Administrative Support: up to \$250,000

A public hearing on the proposed increase will be held on:

Monday, February 24, 2020, 2:30 –3:30 pm

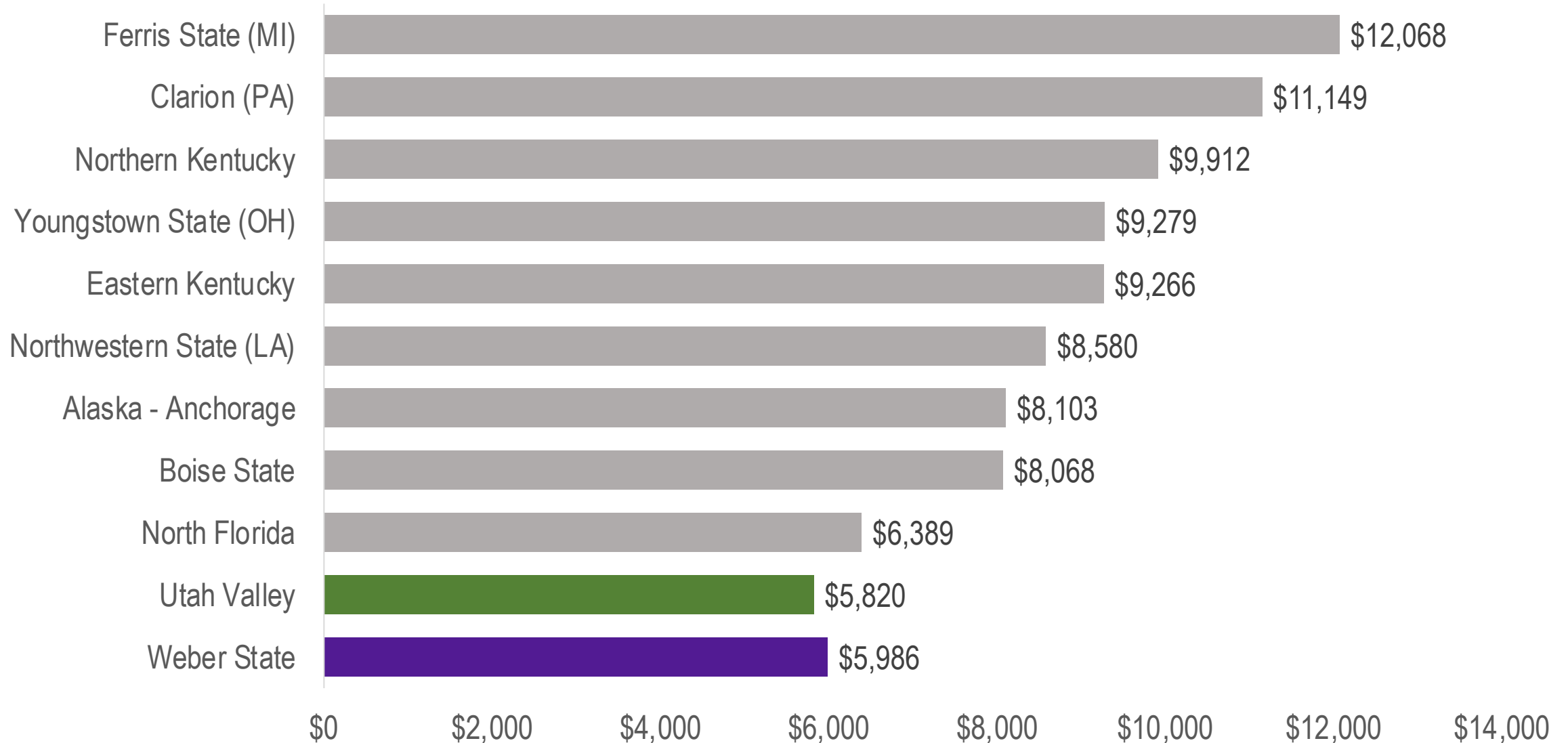

- i. The WSUSA Senate voted unanimously to support administration in 2-3% tuition increase as presented by President Mortensen on 2/24/2020**

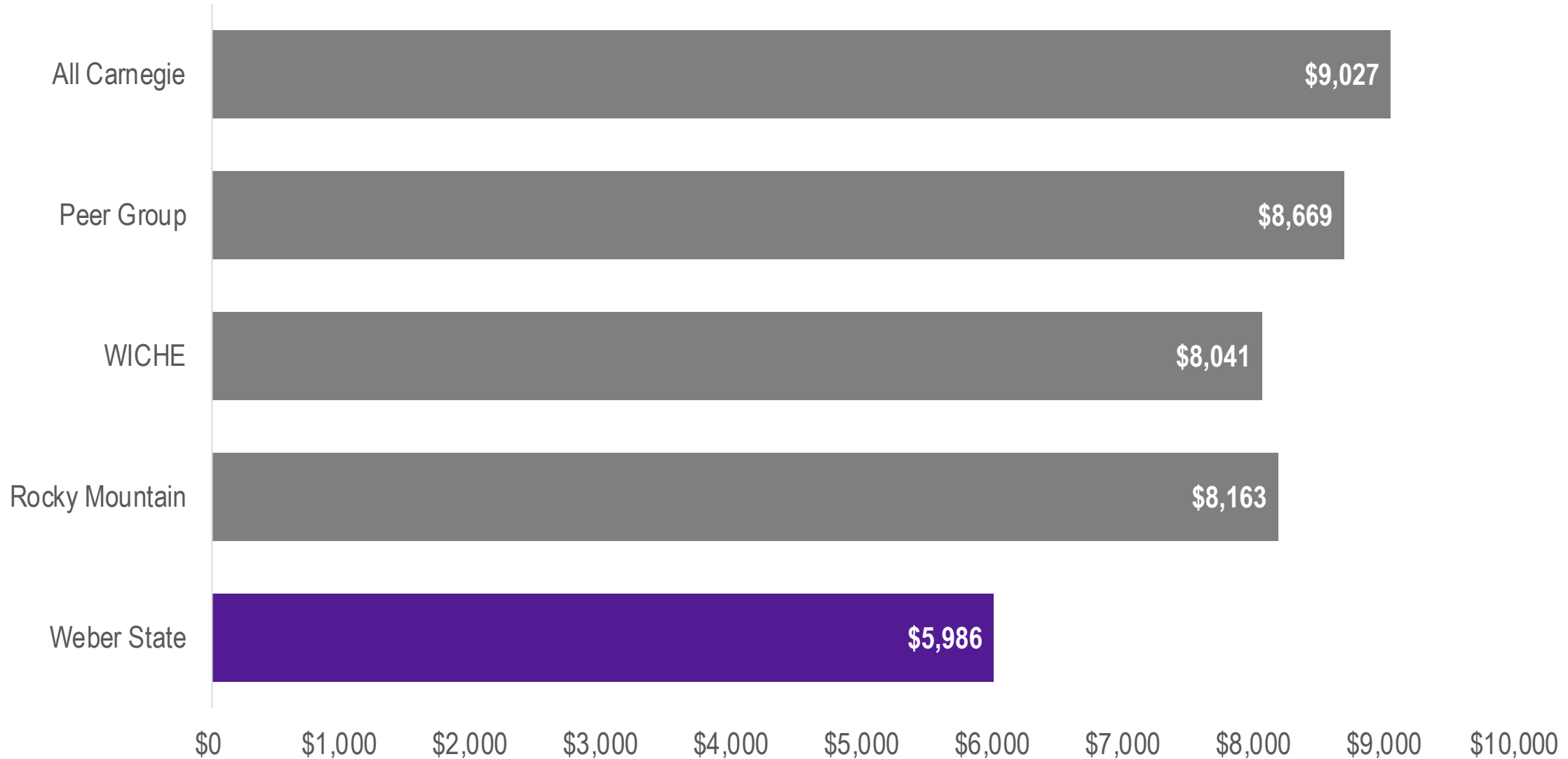
# WSU 2019-20 Tuition Peer Group Comparisons\*

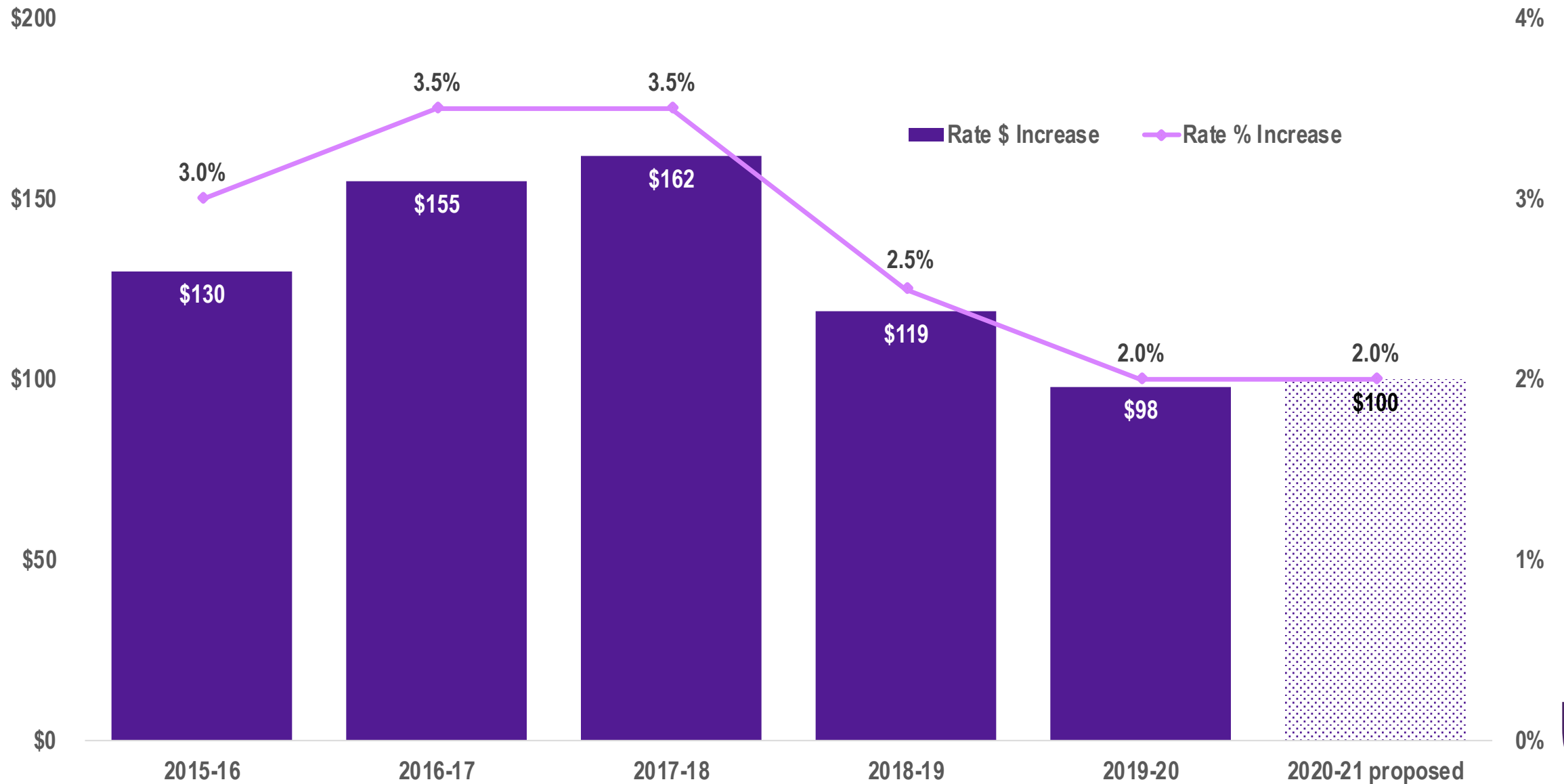

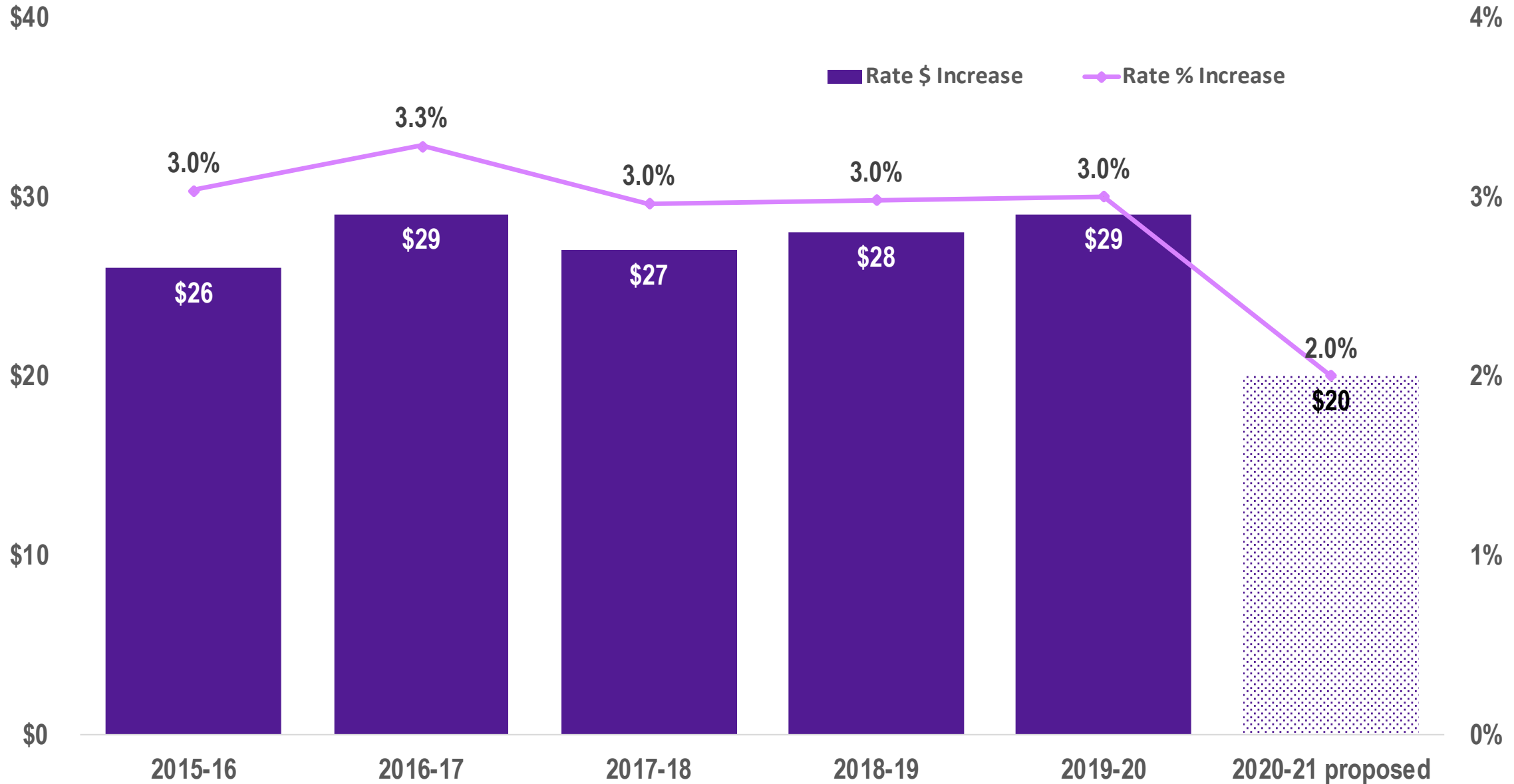
# Five Year Tuition\* Adjustments

# Five Year Student Fee\* Adjustments

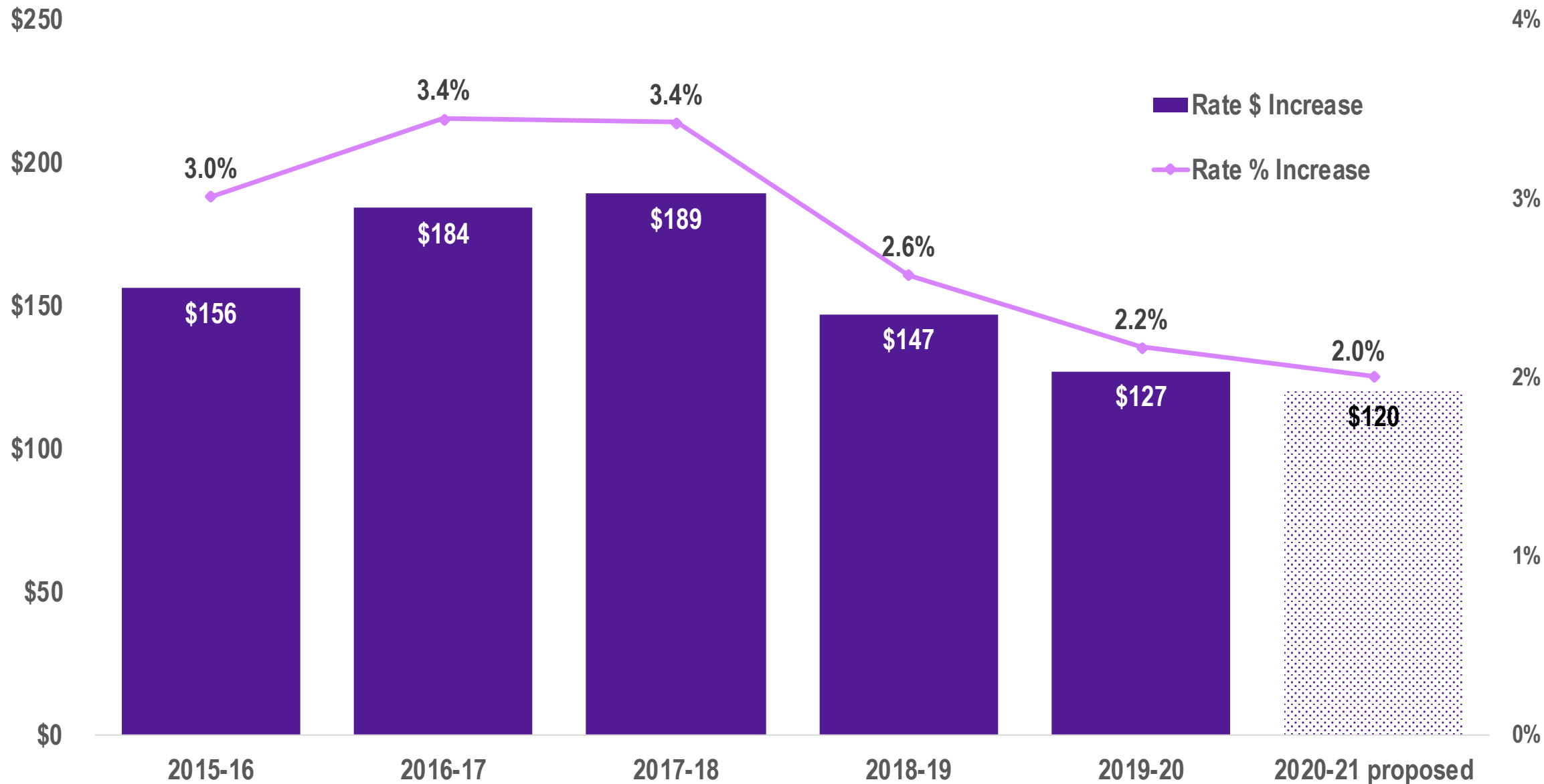
