



HB 333 - Talent Ready Utah

- Currently based at GOUtah (previously GOED)
- Move to USHE mutually supported by all participating entities
- Align to other USHE-based workforce duties
- Continued close collaboration with GO Utah, DWS and USBE
- Enables streamlining and greater accountability of workforce alignment grant and incentive programs to USHE institutions
- Keys to Success partnership

SB226 – Utah Data Research Center (UDRC)

Current Data Sharing

- UDRC established in 2017, located in DWS, focused on longitudinal research
- Limited capabilities b/c of state and federal limitations on data sharing with education entities, workforce indicators

Update USHE Data Services

- Automate data flow to support students (via applications, Keys to Success, scholarships, etc.
- Improve operational metrics
- Update USHE databases

System Data Governance Plan

- Comprehensive plan to manage education data
- Industry standards
- Define necessary technical support and training
- Establish processes for expungement, breaches, etc.
- USHE privacy officer

HB 355 - Streamline State Scholarships

Streamline 16 scholarship programs to 4 "stackable" programs:

- 1. Opportunity (high school merit)
- 2. Promise (high school institution-match)
- 3. Workforce (high school, current student, returning adult)
- 4. Returning adult

SB 172 - Utah Higher Education Assistance Authority (UHEAA)

- Est. 1977, issued federally-backed student loans until 2010
- Since 2010, UHEAA has been a loan servicer to US Dept. of Ed.
- Recent changes have made current model unprofitable/unsustainable
- Oct. 2021 Board action:
 - Sell remaining legacy portfolio
 - Move equity into endowment
 - Endowment proceeds to support student access priorities
