#### FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Southwest Tech provides gap scholarship funding (up to institutional charges) for Paiute Tribe members.


Ogden-Weber Tech: Financial Aid office assists in distributing various tribe/BIA funds to eligible Native/Indigenous students while they are enrolled.

SUU offers a waiver to native students who belong to a tribe, have at least some trust land within Utah or whose reservation or trust land has a border contiguous with Utah. In addition, through a partnership with The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, offers scholarships to students from the Paiute Tribe of Utah.

UVU provides in-state tuition for federally-recognized tribal members, tuition waivers for federally- or state-recognized tribal members with GI and Social Impact HIPS designation, and private funded scholarships for Native students.

Snow provides private scholarship funding for Native American students.







#### NAVIGATIONAL, INCLUSION & BELONGING SUPPORT

Davis Tech, UVU, SLCC, SNOW, and others provide opportunities to honor and celebrate Native Heritage Month.

UVU, UU, USU, and WSU, all have dedicated FTE for supporting Native students navigationally and academically.

UTU and many of the institutions provide a Native American Student Associations (NASA) or Native Student Unions to provide affirming spaces of belonging and thriving networks for Native/Indigenous students


UVU and several other institutions offer scholarships and/or leadership development for students performing in cultural storytelling, dance, or other art forms







- A systemwide agreement on tuition waivers for Native/Indigenous students that is inclusive in its parameters for defining Native/Indigenous students.
- An expansion of the residency waiver to Western
  Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) states supporting access
  to additional Native students, and building larger thriving
  communities of Indigenous students on each USHE
  campus, but specifically impacting growth for Utah
  schools located in the four corners region
- The resources to ensure a dedicated FTE employee supports Native students academically and navigationally.
