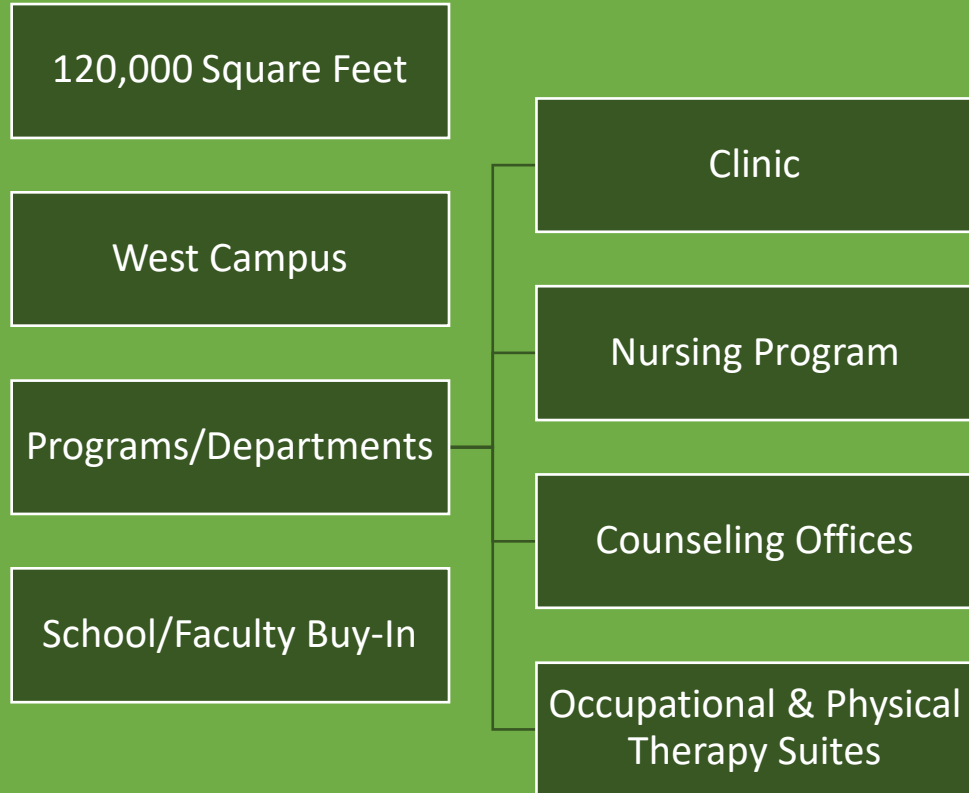

Decision Making Process



R741 Threshold Requirements

Acceptance Rates 2022:

Dental Hygiene:

- 95 applicants, 20 accepted

Physician Assistant (PA):

- 700 applicants, 30 accepted



Need to slowly increase student numbers because any increase requires external specialized accreditation approval.

Cost: \$75,000,000 (Keller Building)
