# Overview of Requests

## Proposed Tuition

- 3.5% increase
- Impacts all students, except online
- Eliminate international online rate

## Proposed Fees

- \$12/semester increase
- Same for both campuses

## Proposed Plateau

- 12-18 credits (instead of 10-20 credits)
- Full fees at six credits

## Goals

- Access: reduced part-time tuition
- Affordability: most affordable in USHE

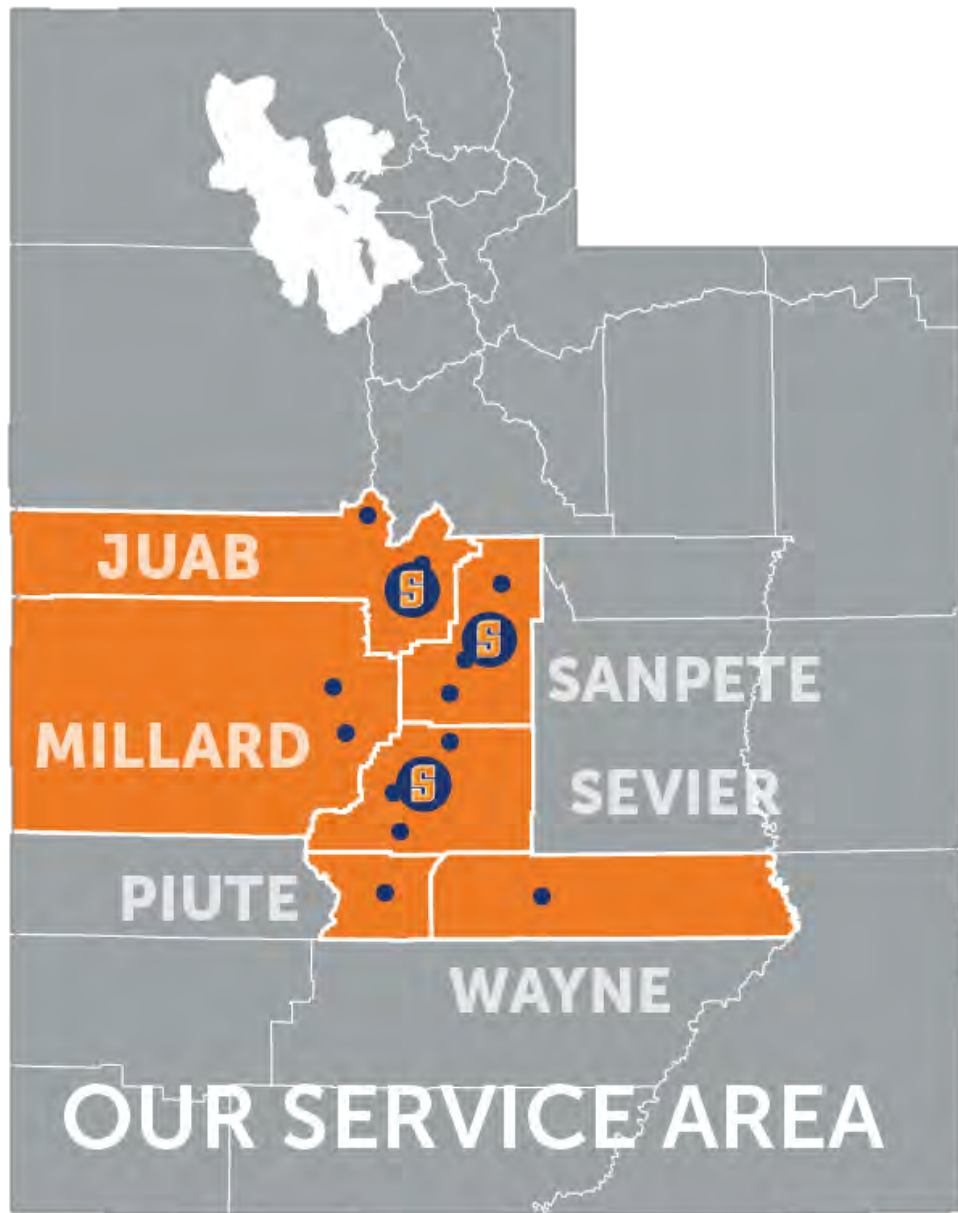
