


Computer Science and Engineering Jobs; 100=Number of Jobs in 2000


Hachman Index State Ranking, 1970-2020








## Social Capital Index, Top Ten States

Share of households that make between two-thirds or double the median household income, 2019



Gini Coefficient, 2022



Mean Income Rank at Age 35 for Children whose Parents Earned \$27,000







#### Utah Adult Median Earnings by Educational Attainment, 2022





#### **Utah Adult Poverty Rate by Educational Attainment, 2022**





#### Utah Adult Unemployment Rate by Educational Attainment, 2022






## Share of Utah Adults with Health Care Coverage by Educational Attainment, 2022

Percent who identify as...




## **Higher Education Builds Civil Society**

#### Utah Civic Engagement by Educational Attainment, 2023





## Median Earnings and Tax Payments of Full-Time Year-Round U.S. Workers by Educational Attainment, 2021






## U.S. Higher Education Enrollment and College-Age Enrollment Rate

## Research Agenda

#### Research Scope of Work

A collection of products to aid decision-makers over next six years

- Economic contribution Each degree-granting institution, technical colleges as a whole, and entire system.
- Technical colleges profiles Impact by college on Utah's workforce and economy.
- Budget stress testing Financial risk exposure for each degree-granting institution.
- Value of higher education Individual and societal benefits of higher education.
- Special projects Such as return on investment and college affordability.

#### **Stress Testing**

Holistically evaluate budget sustainability over time

- Revenue Evaluate historical volatility and future sustainability.
- Spending Examine historical trends, including responsiveness to economic and demographic shifts.
- Buffers Scenario plan a range of budget responses (formal and informal buffers) to manage potential budget gaps.
