FY 2025-2026 Capital Budget Guidance

Dedicated Project Requests

 Degree-granting institutions and technical colleges may submit requests to use anticipated FY 2026 capital project fund balances. Funding subject to appropriations by the Legislature.

Non-Dedicated Project Requests

Each institution may submit one non-dedicated project request.

Landbank Requests

 Should be funded with institution dedicated project allocations, with additional new funding requests provisional on extenuating circumstances.

Non-State Funded Project Requests

 Institutions may submit for Board approval consistent with statute and policy.
