



- Storage room into faculty offices.








# WASHINGTON COUNTY GROWTH

- Population of 465,000 by 2060
- The percentage of the population under 18 will decline from 26.3% in 2020 to 15.4% in 2060, but because of the overall population growth, the number of young people will increase by 65%. Washington County will not experience a demographic cliff.
- Employment in the County will more than double from 2020 to 2060.
- It is expected to be the fastest growing county in Utah between 2020 and 2060.




#### Population Growth: Washington County vs Utah (2011-2023)


