WHEREAS, she graduated with honors from the University of Utah with a bachelor's degree in mathematics and philosophy; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Walia was a finalist for both the Rhodes and Marshall Scholarships, prestigious awards that support postgraduate studies at leading universities in the United Kingdom; and

WHEREAS, she has been accepted into a joint PhD program in Computational Public Policy between Harvard University and New York University;

WHEREAS, throughout her tenure, Ms. Walia enriched the work of the Board of Higher Education and the Utah System of Higher Education by sharing her insights and perspective, serving as an unwavering advocate for students and higher education;
