Deferment Details

Length

Deferment durations vary:

- **2–3 years** is common, with some extending up to 7 semesters
- Some institutions offer flexible or caseby-case durations

Approved Reasons

Deferment durations vary:

- Military service
- Religious missions
- Humanitarian work
- Medical issues
- Other (often includes internships or personal circumstances)

Innovative Deferment Practices

Streamlined Processes

Automated systems simplify deferment requests and ensure scholarships are held during approved absences

Data-Driven Outreach

Dashboards and tracking tools help monitor deferment trends and enable proactive communication

Award Continuity

Policies guarantee equivalent scholarship awards if the original is no longer available upon a student's return

Flexible Accommodations

Case-by-case reviews allow institutions to support diverse student needs and circumstances

Clear Communication

Deferment options are shared through multiple channels, including websites, emails, and advising sessions

Reentry Support

Students who did not defer in advance are often allowed to reapply or appeal for reinstatement

Institutions

 Continue to refine communication & outreach strategies to inform students about all deferment options
