At a glance:


• The number of degrees and awards increased by 1.24% to 42,126 this past fiscal year.

• Number of degrees attained by women (50%) and men (50%) were essentially the same for the past fiscal year.


• Minorities earned 15.9% of the certificates and degrees continuing an upward trend in the percent of awards to minority students.








