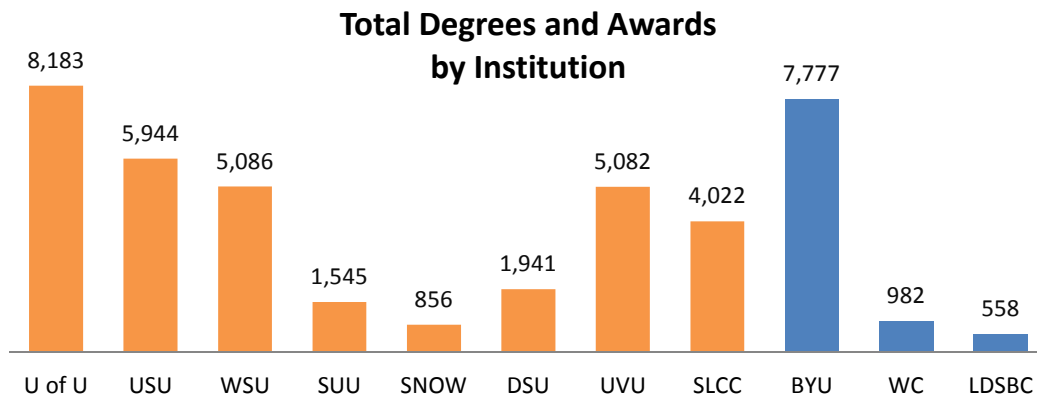

- Bachelors degrees in Business remain in top demand among students with Health Professions staying in second place ahead of Social Sciences. Education and Psychology complete the top five in 2014-15
- Number of degrees attained by women (51%) outpaced men (49%) in the 2014-15 fiscal year.

Academic Years 2003 - 2014

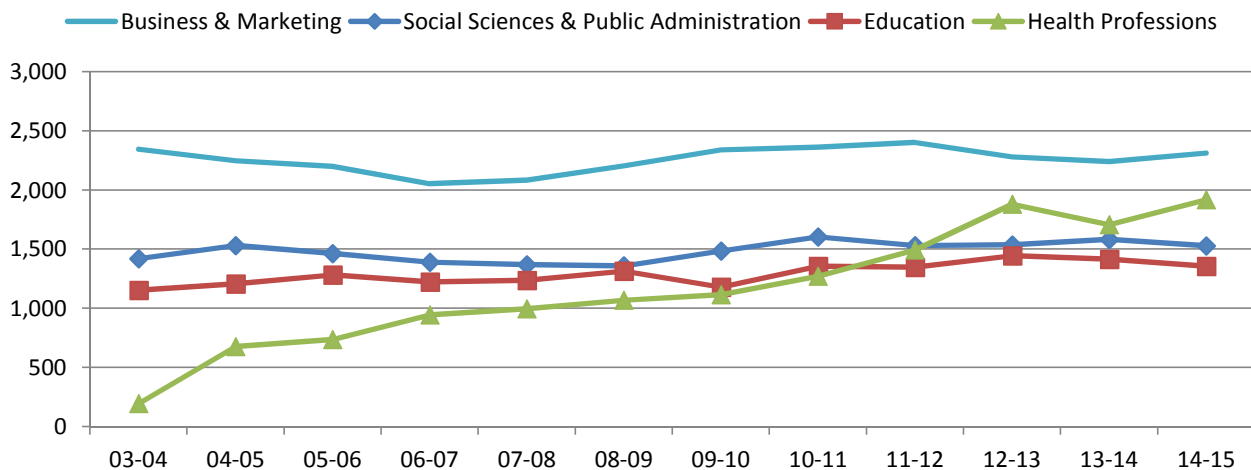

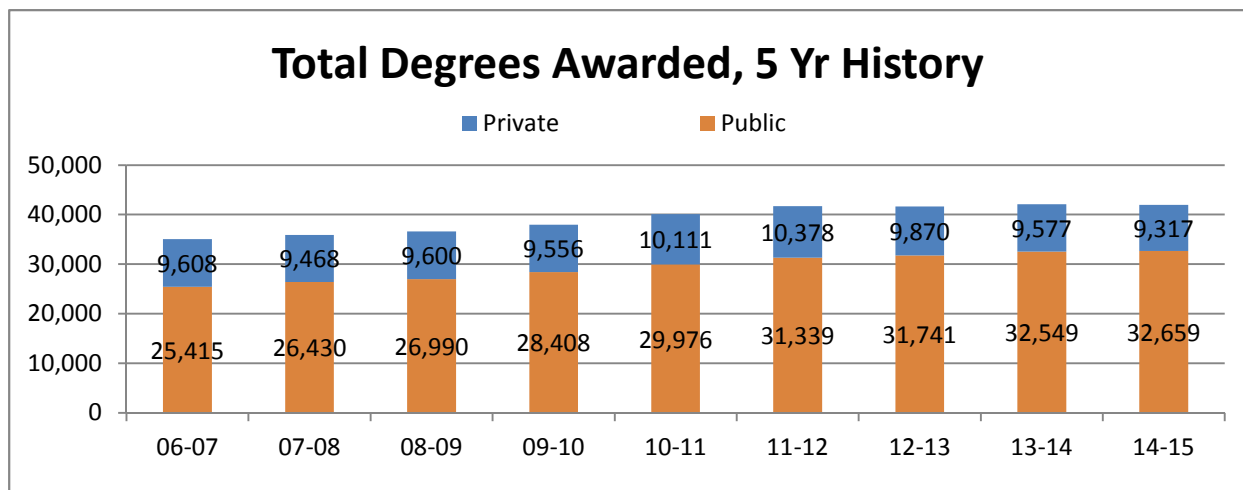

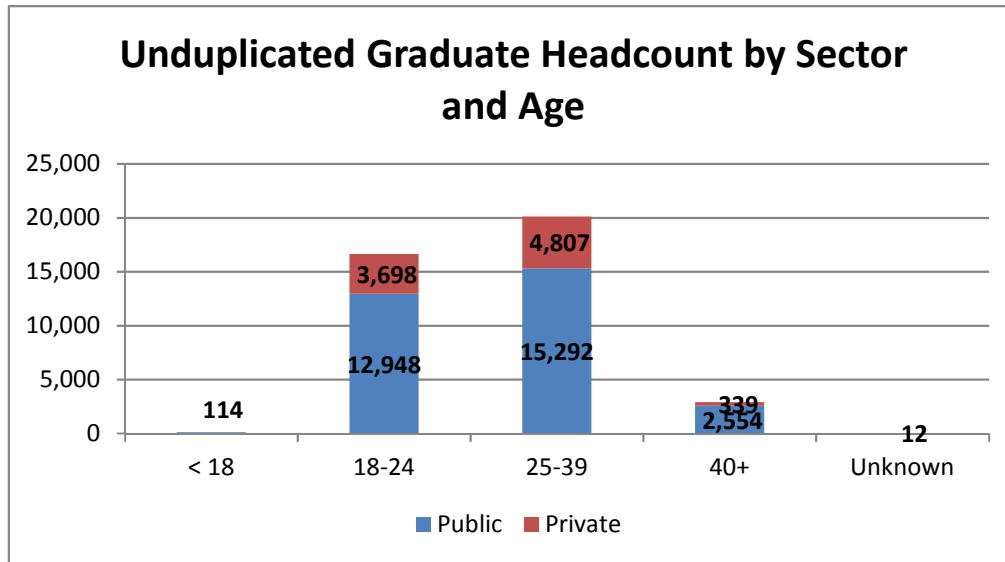

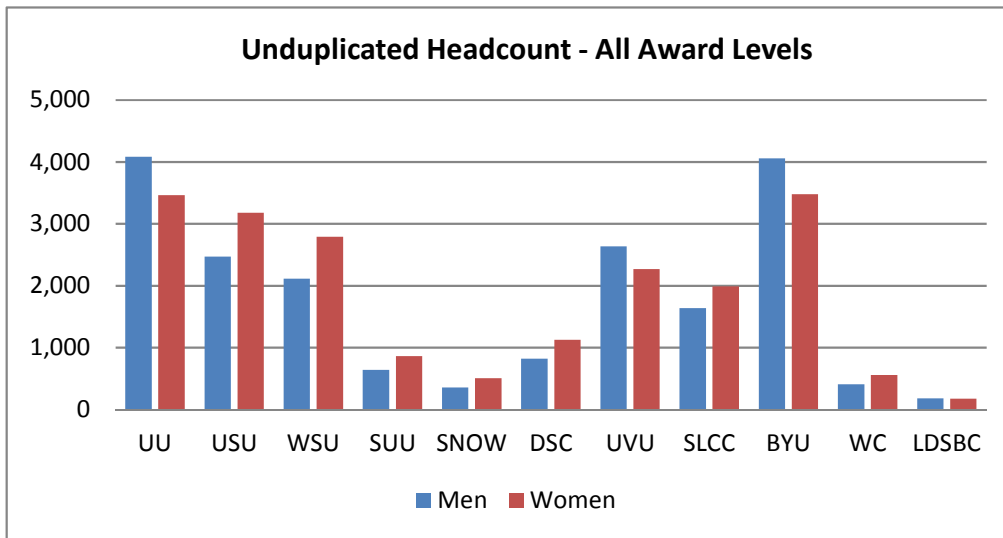

**Unduplicated Headcount of Graduates by Ethnicity**

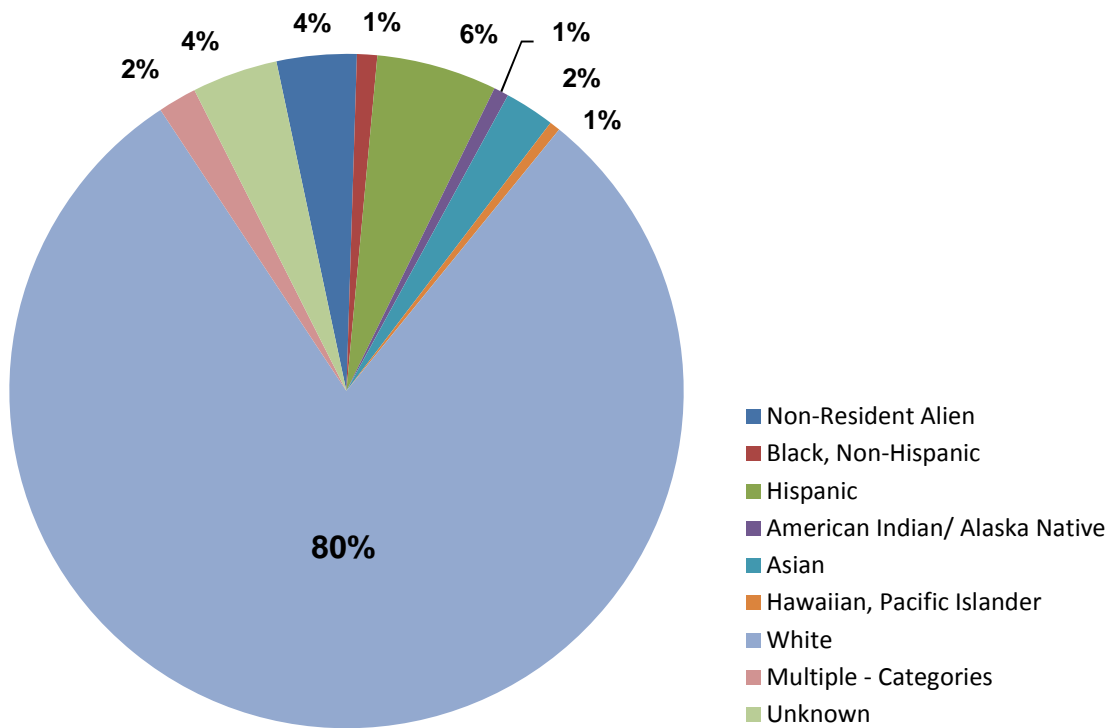
