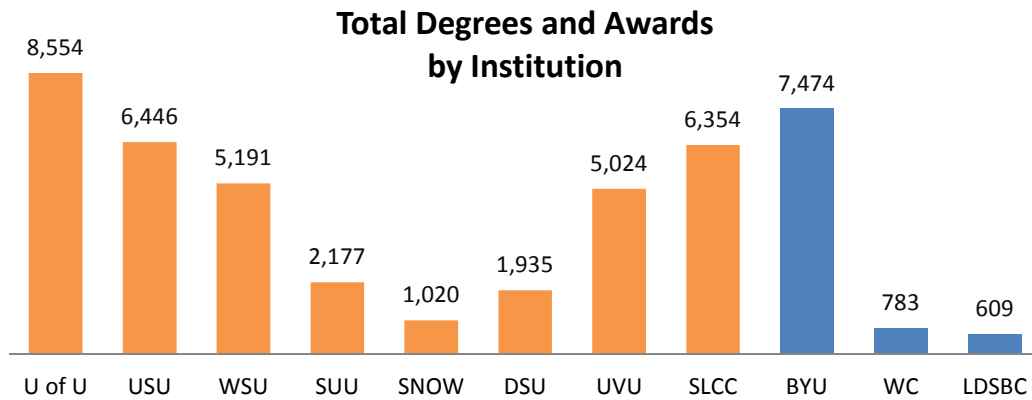

## At a glance:

- The number of degrees and awards increased by 5.87% to 45,567 this past fiscal year.
- Bachelors degrees in Business remain in top demand among students with Health Professions staying in second place ahead of Social Sciences and Education. Engineering & Related Technologies replaced Psychology in the fifth spot of the top five in 2016-17
- Number of degrees attained by women (22,942) was slightly higher than men (22,625) in the 2016-17 fiscal year.

## Top Bachelors Degrees Awarded by USHE Academic Years 2006 - 2017

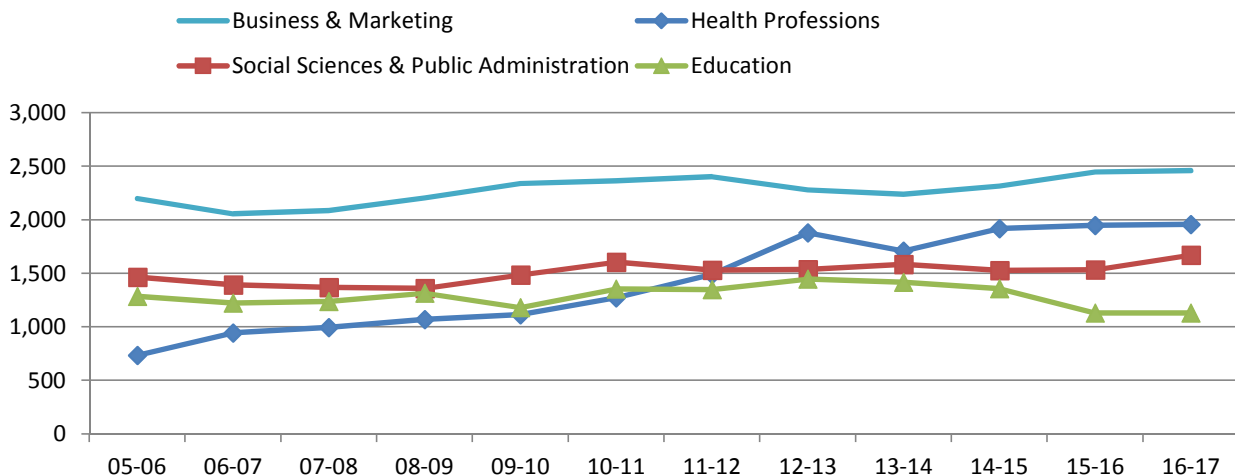

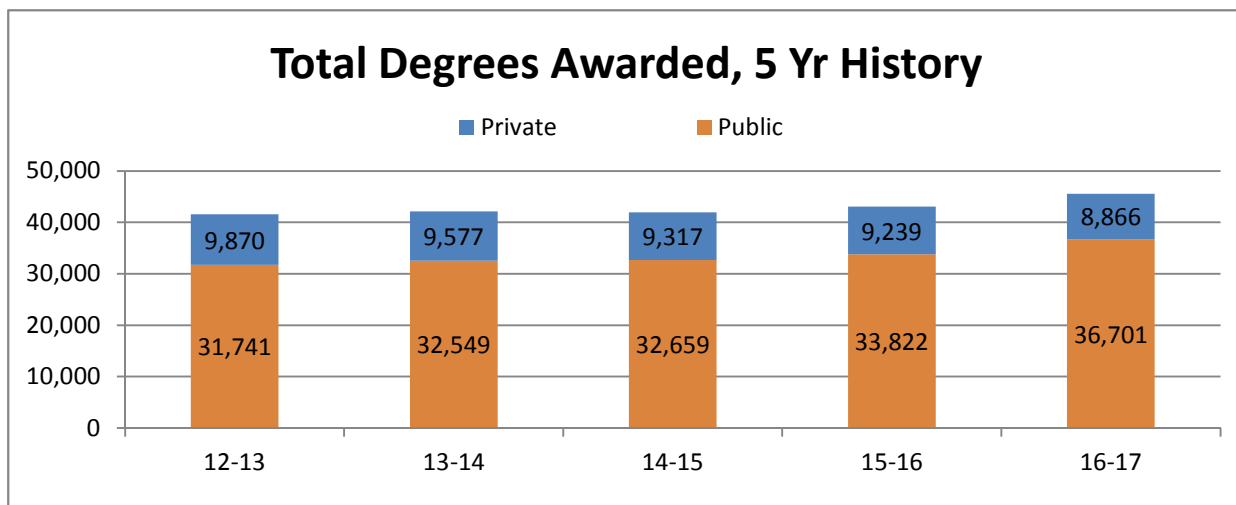

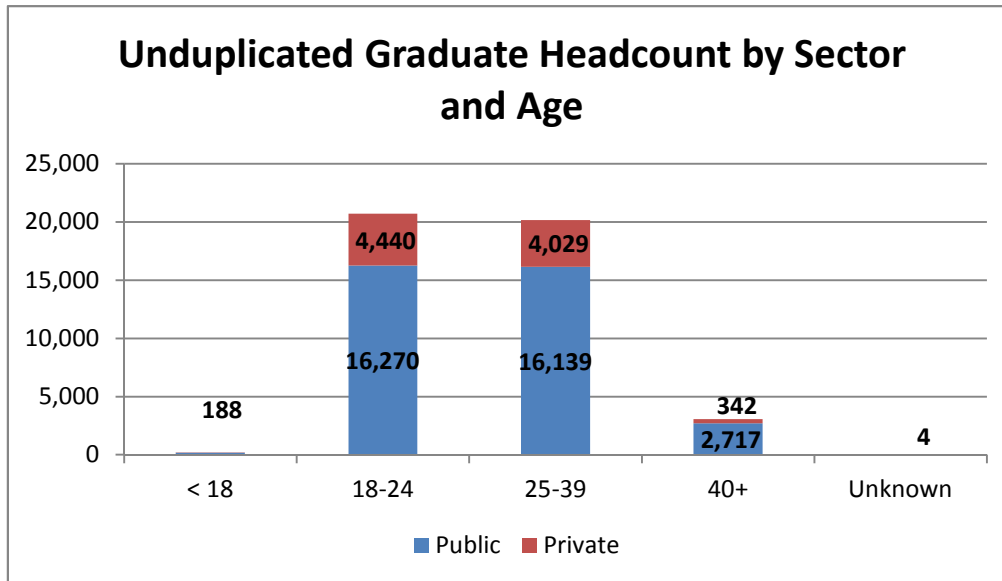

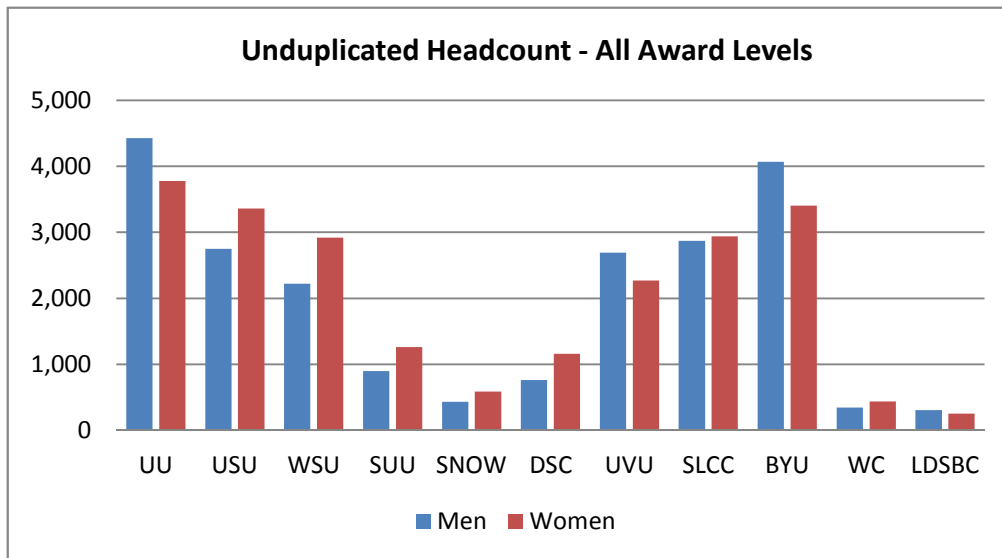

**Unduplicated Headcount of Graduates by Ethnicity**

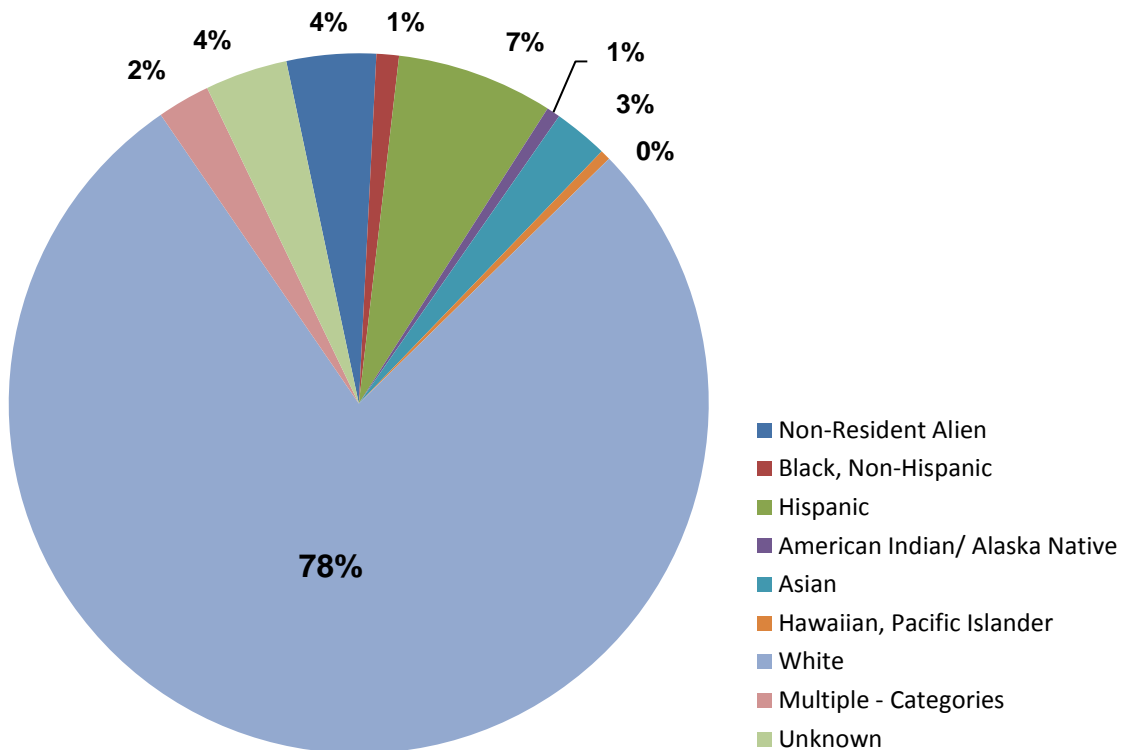
