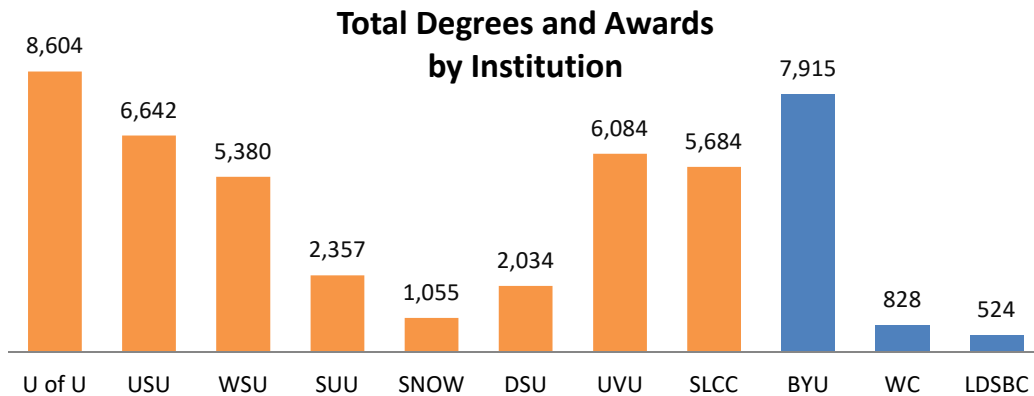

At a glance:

- The number of degrees and awards increased by 1,456 to 47,023 this past fiscal year.
- Bachelors degrees in Business remain in top demand among students with Health Professions staying in second place ahead of Social Sciences. Engineering & Related Technologies replaced Education in the 4th spot and Education fell to the fifth spot of the top five in 2017-18.
- Women earned 51% of degrees and awards (24,044) compared to 49% by men (22,979) in the 2017-18 fiscal year.

Academic Years 2007 - 2018

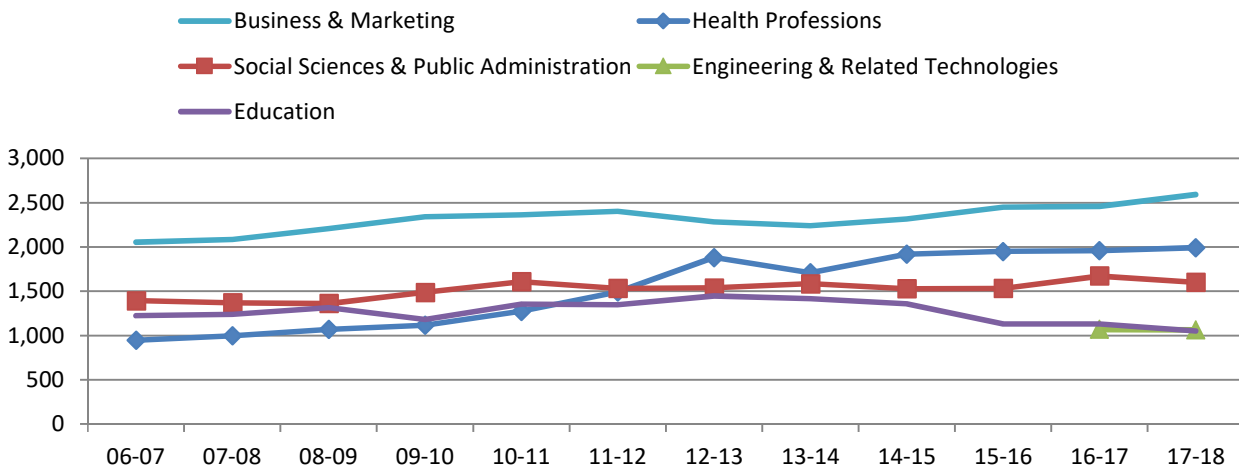

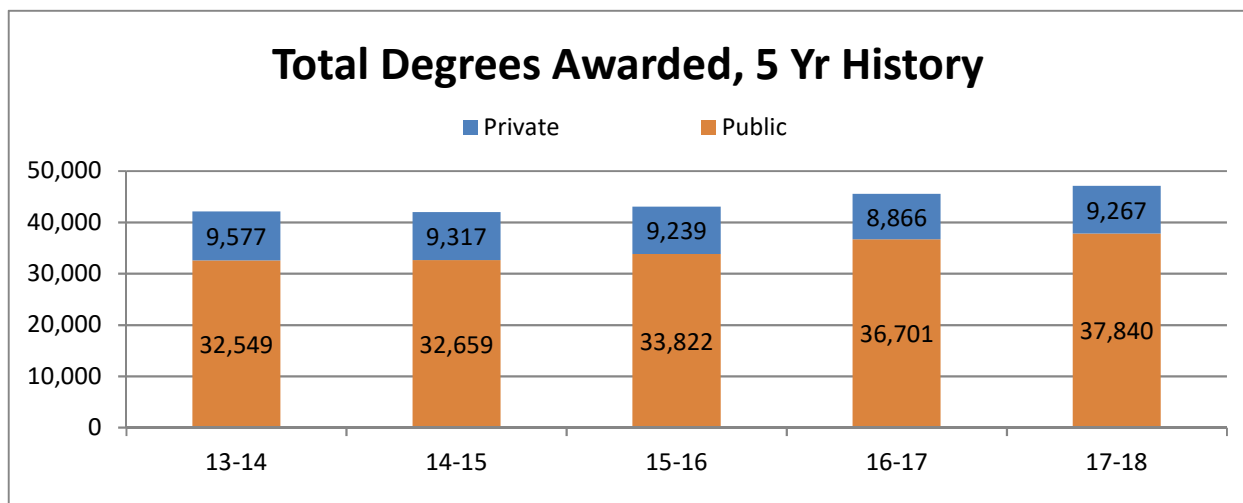

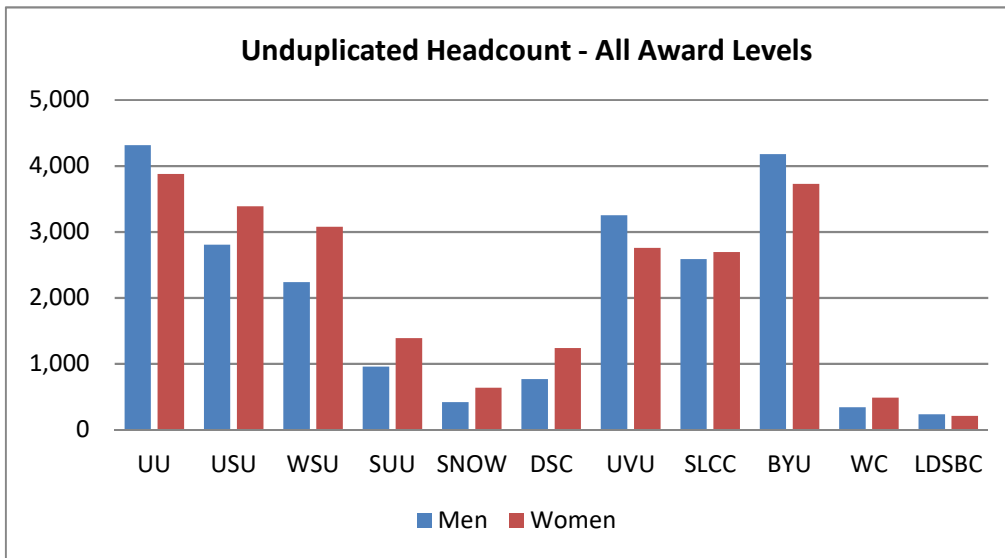

Unduplicated Headcount of Graduates by Ethnicity

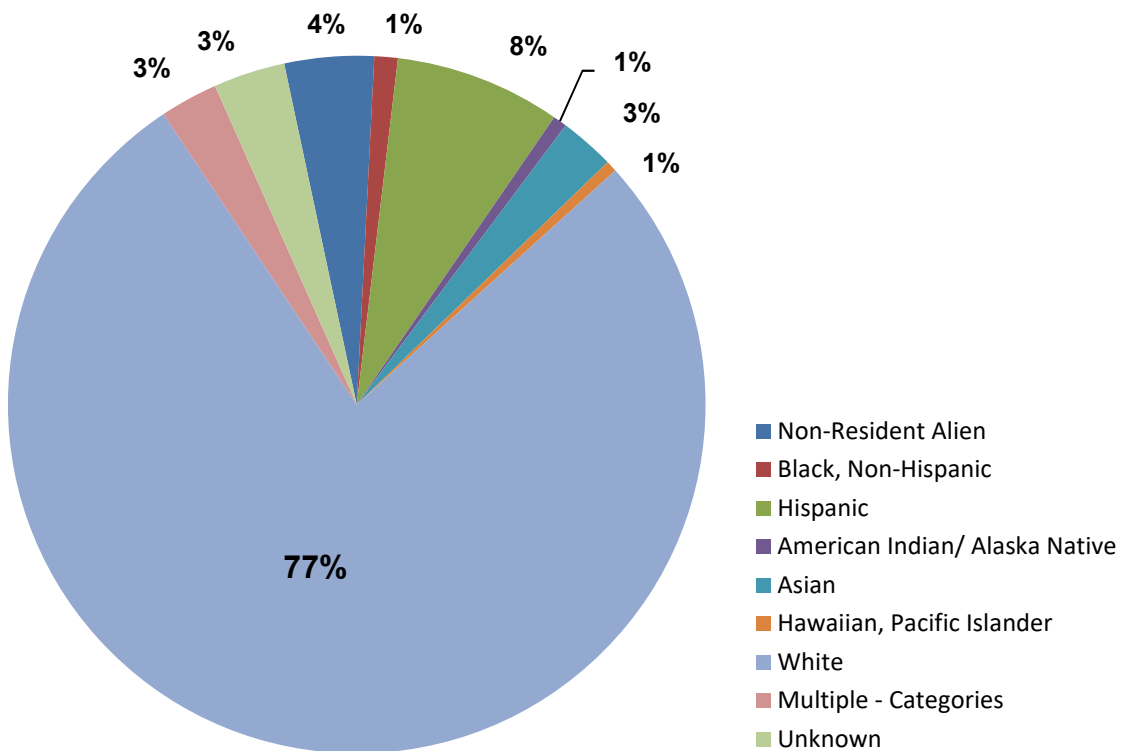
