

- The number of degrees and awards Increased by 1,355 to 48,462 this past fiscal year.
- Bachelors degrees in Business remain in top demand among students with Health Professions staying in second place ahead of Social Sciences. Education replaced Engineering & Related Technologies in the 4th spot and Engineering & Related Technologies fell to the fifth spot of the top five in 2018-19.
- Women earned 52% of degrees and awards (25,249) compared to 49% by men (23,001) in the 2018-19 fiscal year.

Academic Years 2008 - 2019





Unduplicated Headcount of Graduates by Ethnicity


