

LEY General Education Navigator/Academic Year 2023-24

UVU's General Education (GE) program provides the subject-area knowledge and learning skills foundation for 2- and 4-year degrees. Core and Institution courses make up the general education foundation. Breadth courses give an opportunity to explore various subjects. GE courses are highly advisable for concurrent enrollment students; they are required for college graduation and transferable from one Utah System of Higher Education (USHE) institution to another. It is possible to complete UVU's GE requirements by taking 5-6 concurrent enrollment classes each, junior and senior year plus registering separately for a 2 credit Wellness class.
