

## **General Education Navigator/Academic Year 2025-26**

General Education courses are highly advisable for concurrent enrollment students as they are the foundation for 2- and 4-year degrees; they are required for college graduation and transferable from one Utah System of Higher Education (USHE) institution to another.

It is possible to complete SLCC's GenEd Requirements by taking 5 CE Courses in Junior Year and 5 CE Courses in Senior Year.
