- Work with one organization (can choose best fit/interest)
- ➤ 10-12 month period
- Training through AmeriCorps, UServeUtah and organization
- Benefits during and after service
- > Certain eligibility requirements

Using the Education Award

- Current Educational Expenses tuition, books, room and board, etc (within 7 yrs)
 - eligible schools participate in the Dept of Education's Title IV student aid programs (most post-secondary colleges, universities, and technical schools)

Repay Qualified Student Loans

- Loans backed by the federal government under Title IV of the Higher Education Ac (except PLUS Loans to parents of students)
- ➤ Loans under Titles VII or VIII of the Public Service Health Act
- > Loans made by a state agency, including state institutions of higher education

Schools of National Service

Select Schools may offer:

- Tuition matching for the Segal AmeriCorps Education Award
- Scholarship or fellowship to AmeriCorps alumni
- Priority admission consideration for AmeriCorps alumni
- Academic credit for AmeriCorps experience

In Utah this includes: Westminster College and Broadview College.

*Arizona, Maryland, and Nebraska offer in-state tuition to AmeriCorps alumni
