




The Goal

 Complete at least one college or university application during the school day (UCAW)

AND

 Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid during a coordinated FAFSA Night event with access to parents.



Events will run OCT. 2, 2023 – NOV. 17, 2023

Why is College Access Important?

Interventions to Improve College Access

Admissions: The process to get into college such as research, applications, high school transcripts and college visits.

Enrollment: The process of making a commitment to attend an institution and take specific classes.



UCAW acts as a catalyst to help high school seniors navigate the complex college application and admissions process.

FAFSA Completion's effect on college enrollment

FAFSA Completion's Effect on Enrollment

- Statewide FAFSA Completion
- FAFSA Nights integrated with UCAW Events

"Among students from the graduating class of 2013, **91.5% of** students who completed a FAFSA had a postsecondary enrollment...,compared to 49.7% of students without a FAFSA completion. This represents an 84% increase in the likelihood of enrollment associated with FAFSA completion." (National College Access Network, 2019)

Proactive Ideas: FSA ID

- Work with students to complete their FSA ID before the FAFSA opens.
- Provide extra credit opportunities for students who complete their FSA ID (at home or school).
- Maybe host events during school (students) or after school (families).
- Pair your FSA ID events with Utah College Application Week.
 - *Our office will not be coordinating any official FSA ID-type events nor providing any official assistance

The hope for all of this is that when your students complete the FSA ID in the fall, they won't have to worry about it while filing the FAFSA in the spring.

Let's Talk UCAW

Tasks & Set-up

How does it work? USHE Tasks

- Provide ongoing training and support to site coordinators and teams, as well as district liaisons, email communications, troubleshooting, and publications
- Provide "how to" manual with examples, templates, and worksheets
- Provide UCAW Coordinator survey for data tracking
- State-wide media and promotion, including events, press releases, TV/radio, proclamation, and coordinate appearances by officials

UCAW Models

- Core Class: Host UCAW during (usually English) class.
- Technology: Requires multiple computer labs/laptop sets, entire senior class online at once
- Hybrid: Seniors designate the school they want to apply to, college reps are scheduled for these specific days
- Non-Core Class: Seniors pulled from non-core courses. (not all seniors are taking the same non-core courses at the same time)
- Minimal Resources: One day for UCAW
- Distance Learning Model: UCAW is hosted mainly as an online event

Sample High School Tasks

- 1. Register school
- 2. Help to create team, reserve lab, and add event on school master calendar
- 3. Market and communicate the opportunity to staff, students, families, and the community
- 4. Identify volunteers involved to assist with the event
- 5. Prepare students for the event required docs
- 6. School-wide activities to build college awareness
- 7. UCAW Events Check-in, application, fee waivers, survey, FAFSA
 - FAFSA Night component in Spring 2024
- 8. Follow-up with students

Data Collection

- In years past, the Senior Exit survey was provided to schools to administer to students to gather data on their event. To help reduce the number of surveys administered to students from USHE <u>AND</u> achieve the goal of UCAW which is to focus on students applying to college, **USHE will ask UCAW Coordinators to submit a survey after their event to help collect data**.
 - Number of transcripts sent to colleges during UCAW
 - Number of seniors who participated during UCAW <u>or</u> senior 2023 class size
 - Success stories from you school's participation in UCAW
 - OPTIONAL: Number of **completed** college applications during UCAW


Why Register Your High School?






