Scholarship Index

Utah Resident (First-Year)

- · Only one score (GPA or ACT or SAT) is required for all scholarships except President's
- · Best score is used for scholarships requiring only one score
- · Minimum 2.3 GPA required for scholarships awarded based upon ACT or SAT
- GPA scale is unweighted (4.00 is highest)

ACT and SAT scores DO NOT include the Writing sections of the exams
