STEP 1 | SUBMIT YOUR TRANSCRIPTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP CONSIDERATION

You have already been admitted, however, in order to be considered for scholarship you still need to submit your latest high school transcripts. Talk with your official high school counselor to have your transcripts sent to UVU. uvu.edu/admissions/whatsnext

STEP 2 | COMPLETE ORIENTATION

It is easy. The first part is online. Orientation assists new students in finding success at UVU and is required to register for classes. You can find all the info you need to have a successful first year. uvu.edu/orientation

STEP 3 I CONTACT YOUR ACADEMIC ADVISOR
